Deliverance the End Time Ministry:

1. Intro
 1. Deliverance “The End Time Ministry”
 - a. (Chapter 1 in “So Free” book)
 - b. Americas Dysfunction – Worlds Dysfunction would be a better title.
 2. Lot – An OT example
 1. Lot hung out with the world. The customs of the world were comfortable to him and therefore “normal”.
 3. America’s Dysfunction
 1. Divorce
 - a. 60% marriage ends in divorce. Studies show “born again” believers have higher rate.
 - b. Malachi 2:16 God hates divorce
 1. If you have been divorced it’s history and under the blood
 2. If believer divorced (without cause) is sin and marriage should be healed.
 - c. Quadrupled from 1970 4.3 million to 17.6 million in 1995
 - d. 1 out of 11 adults are divorced
 - e. Children of divorce are more likely to:
 1. Have Premarital sex
 2. Endorse cohabitation
 3. Express negative attitudes towards marriage
 4. Accept divorce
 - f. Children of divorce in childhood significantly relates to emotional problems, poor school performance, and lower economic standing.
 - g. Child’s experience does not peak and level off. It remains cumulative and impact increases over time. The affect of divorce is replayed over first 30 years of life.
 1. Mom and Dad move on and get new relationship.
 - h. Number one of sexual abusers dealt with in deliverance ministry of Bill Sudduth is step-fathers followed by Mom’s boyfriend. “You need to know who your child is with”.
 - i. Article “Divorce- No ticket to happiness” (20 yr research) studied couples who sought marriage counseling compared to ½ that divorced and ½ that did not over a 20 year tracking.
 1. Couples who stayed together through problems most were still married and happy. Because they worked through it together.
 2. Couples that divorced had repeated divorces 2-3 times. Unhappy 20 years later and they never learned how to deal with complications.
 - a. No person or thing (addiction) can make you happy. Except Jesus!
 1. We have 3 voids
 - a. Empty place that Christ fills
 - b. Empty space Baptism of Holy Spirit fills
 - c. Empty space filled when we fulfill our calling from God
 - j. So Free Book Statistics
 1. 24.7 million 36% of all children do not live with biological father.
 2. 17 million 25% living with single mother households have not see father in at least a year.
 3. 50% have never set foot in their father’s house.
 2. Television
 - a. Dumbing down dad’s

- b. Article about this indicates programs like Archie Bunker, The Jefferson's, then Al Bundy, and Soprano's made fathers look like fools and it molds children and society's opinions of fathers.
- 3. Teen Sex
 - a. 63% of teens "make out"
 - b. 55% of teens 15 and older have had sexual intercourse
 - c. 294,000 infect each other each week with a STD
 - d. Dr. Dobson states 65 million Americans have a form of STD
 - e. 45 million Have herpes
 - f. People under 25 years-old get 2/3 of the 25 million STD's each year
 - g. 5000 women per year die of cervical cancer related to a virus that is sexually transmitted.
- 4. Drugs
 - a. 1.4 million Teens using heroine
 - 1. Which is more pure (potent), cheaper, and readily available then before
 - b. Devil is after our children
- 5. Abortion
 - a. Those 30 yrs. or younger would have been largest generation of all time if not for 40 million Abortions
 - b. Devil is afraid of our children and he gets power by their shed blood of disobedience.
- 6. Teen Facts
 - a. Teen media published a booklet section "Statistical Outrage"
 - 1. Following from it:
 - a. More than 1/2 the nations college students drank to get drunk last year
 - b. 52% 1996 -1997 drinking to get drunk compared to 39% in 1993
 - 2. A 1995 study found:
 - a. The more a teenager felt loved by parents the more they did well in school. They were less likely to have sex, smoke, do drug or alcohol, abuse or to commit violence or suicide.
 - b. If parents expected them to
 - i. Get good grades
 - ii. Refrain from sex
 - c. It greatly influenced their behavior
 - 3. Children listen more than we think, they also watch what we do (learn by example)
- 7. TV. Violence and Sex
 - a. Children watch avg. 3-4 hours TV daily
 - b. 100's of students
 - 1. Become immune to horror and violence
 - 2. Gradually accept violence as a way to solve problems
 - 3. Imitating violence is seen
 - 4. Identifying with characters (victim or victimizer)
 - c. Violent programs on TV lead to aggressive behavior by children and teenagers who watch those programs.
 - 1. 1992 report from National Institute of Mental Health. (Confirmed and extended an earlier study by the Surgeon General).
 - d. 3 Major effects of seeing violence
 - 1. Children become less sensitive to pain and suffering of others.
 - 2. Children may be more likely to behave in aggressive or harmful ways towards others.

3. Children who watched violent shows even “just funny” cartoons were more likely to strike out at their playmates to disobey class rules, leave tasks unfinished, and were less willing to wait for things than those who watched the non violent programs.

Decapitated Mom

“Two brothers who allegedly killed their mother, then cut off her head , hands and dumped the body in California forest., were copying an episode of the hit television series “ The Sopranos”, police said on Friday.

Jason Bautista, a 20 year old college student and his 15 year old brother, were arrested after police found their mothers severed head and hands stuffed at home.

The mutilated corpse of 41 year old Jane Marie Bautista, clad only in underwear, was discovered on Jan. 15 at the bottom of a rock strewn ravine in the Cleveland National Forest, in Orange County about 60 miles south of Las Angeles.

On the show it was explained to get away with murder they need to cut off the head and hands. Caught because of a witness who saw them dump the body.”

- f. Average news broad cast contains as much violence, sex and action as many popular entertainment shows.

8. TV

- a. Of the 1351 TV programs airing now 56% of them contain explicit sex
Countless others have sexual content or promote anti- Christian values such as homosexuality, premarital sex, and witchcraft.
- b. Average child sees 16000 murders before high school
- c. Teens in the U.S. get pregnant more often; have more babies and more abortions than teens in any other developed nation.

9. Eating Disorders

- a. Bulimia thought to affect 4 out of 100 women between age 17 and 25
- b. Many high School girls in America believe they are overweight but in actuality are not.
 1. (Girls who think they are overweight compared to truth)

High School Grade	Actually Overweight	Believe they are Overweight
9 th - Freshman	7.7 %	33.4%
10 th - Sophomore	6.6%	35.6%
11 th - Junior	6.7%	35.7%
12 th - Senior	6.3%	35.9%

- c. Anorexia 1 in 100 between age 17 and 25

10. Teen Issues

- a. Next 24 hours (based on national organization.)
 1. 3,506 teens run away
 2. 1,439 attempt suicide
 3. 2,759 become pregnant
 4. 15,006 use drug for the first time

11. Video Games

- a. Dungeon and Dragons:

- a. According to an attorney representing a suicide victim's family: "It is a game that tells kids how to perfect the art of pre-mediated murder."
- b. Shooters of Columbine school played before the shooting.
- c. National coalition on TV violence "Dungeon and Dragons" is linked to over 50 teen deaths.
- d. Bill Sudduth nephew had a paper that on which he plotted his murder for "Dungeon and Dragons."
- e. This began a wave of demonic role playing games.
- f. Ever Quest
 - 1. Billed as "Worlds #1 fantasy adventure game"
 - 2. Warning on its states that it may cause or induce seizures
 - 3. About killing, destroying, magic and witch craft
 - 4. Characters: "Beast Lord", "Druid", "Enchanter", "Necromancer", "Shaman", "Warrior", "Wizard".
 - 5. Conjure up demons in game and these demons help you navigate the game

12. Article of **"Death Of A Game Addict"**

- a. "A Hudson man took his own life after long hours on Wed" by Stanley A. Miller of the Journal Sentinel Staff last updated: March 30, 2002
Shawn Woolley loved an online computer game so much that he played it just minutes before his suicide.
The 21 year old Hudson man was addicted to Ever Quest, says his mother Elizabeth Woolley of Osceola. He sacrificed everything so he could play for hours, ignoring his family, quitting his job and losing himself in a 3-D virtual world. Where more than 400,000 people worldwide adventure in a never-ending fantasy. "It's like any other addict," Elizabeth Woolley said last week, "Either you die, go insane or you quit. My son died."

13. If the devil cannot get you in the demonic stuff he will get you in the innocent stuff.

- a. Example: Friends birthday party "Monsters Inc". had everything for theme
 - 1. Janet asked about it and she was told to "get a life"
 - 2. Janet asked: What if a spirit comes in and takes form of one of the characters and that characters voice and says to your child "can we play", then "can I come in so we can play all the time".
 - 3. These parents rejected this thought.
 - 4. Later, during another conference, a couple came up and asked about "Monsters Inc." at a "Cleansing Stream Seminar".
 - 5. When Bill told her about the conversation Janet had a couple days before these parents were upset
 - 6. Later at the next session the mother told Bill about how after the conversation the week before they went and picked up her daughter from Missionettes.
 - 7. On the way home "I started talking to my 7 year old and told her what Bill stated "Her daughter covered her ears, started rocking and laughing evilly"
 - 8. Her husband almost wrecked the car
 - 9. Daughter was playing "Monsters Inc. on a Game boy
 - 10. They disposed of the game immediately
 - 11. Daughter started whimpering "You told me you would buy the movie" as she continued rocking.
 - 12. They purged all Monsters Inc. from their home and then burned it all

13. Daughter cried during this “mommy, mommy, mommy”.
14. Bill believes it was an idol in Childs life
15. You may not have issues in your home with this movie or others like it - this is not legalistic. But we need to pray and ask God before bringing it in or allowing it to remain.

14. Computers

- a. If used wrong is evil
- b. 1/3 of all internet hits are porn sites
- c. 1500 new porn sites are added weekly to the internet
- d. 80% of all web sites are porn
- e. Porn sites have polluted the internet.
