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23. So how do we apply this to this principality called Fear?

- a. God doesn't need to come down here and live and to do something.
- b. We don't need to cry out and say: "Oh God if you'll just come down here and set me free of all these thoughts these tormenting things."
- c. He's up there crying and says:
 - i. I've done it all! Jesus Christ - He died and rose again! I gave Him authority! He came back here to earth! He gave it to you!
 - ii. Go read the last chapter of Matthew. Go read the last chapter of Mark:
 - iii. You take authority! You have a free will! It's your choice!
 - iv. Sure it's a battle! But I've given you my armor! I've given you my word! I've given you my Holy Spirit!
 - v. Would you do it? The battle is yours.
- d. Isaiah 45:18-19
 - i. **[Isaiah 45:18-19 (KJV)]**¹⁸ For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I *am* the LORD; and *there is* none else.¹⁹ I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek ye me in vain: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right.]
 - ii. God said the earth shall be inhabited in righteousness in people who were in right standing with me.
 - iii. Not by demons. Not by devils. Not by fear. Not by rejection, unloving or accusation. But by men and women of God.
- e. If you've been called out by God then we need to be brave, bold and trusting in the Lord God Almighty.
- f. We're not to be moved by our feelings, our thoughts and emotions, wherever they might have come; from in our past, in our upbringing, when we were 2, 3, 4, or 5. When we don't even remember what was programmed into us.
- g. But we're to be moved by faith and trust God and have a desire to praise him and to worship him and to honor God Almighty in every area of our life, including our feelings and our emotions.

24. [Slide: **Matthew 6:33 (KJV)** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.]

- a. It says: [Paraphrased] "Seek ye first the kingdom of God and his righteousness and all these things: peace, justice, security, love, all these things shall be added unto you."
- b. I encourage you to read the word of God and stay focused on what God says.
- c. Kick out Fear and say: "Lord though I don't feel it though I don't know how to do it, I'm going to trust you and what your word says."
- d. I encourage you. I exhort you to know the word of God: for your health, for your peace and for your freedom.

25. Now, especially the Christians, there is a faith that is a counterfeit and it's called Fear-Faith.

- a. It counterfeits real faith and you're not asking God out of real faith but out of fear-need.

A Counterfeit To Faith

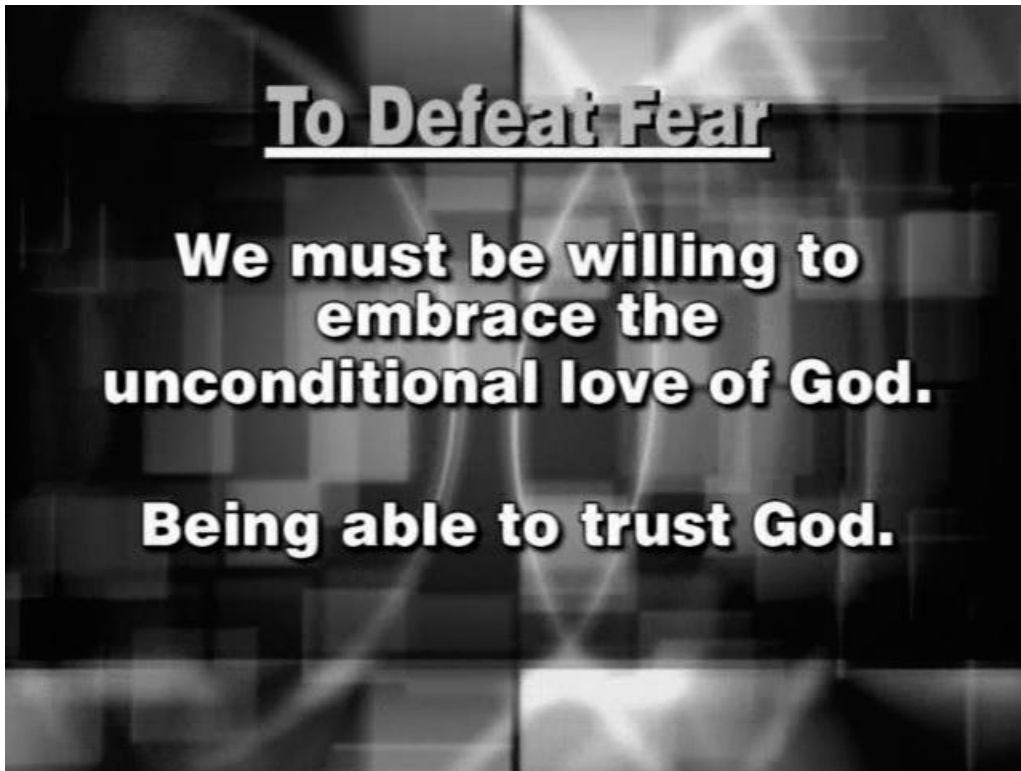
Fear-Faith:

**When you do not ask God
out of real faith but out
of fear-need.**

**Fearful that your need
will not be met,
then you pray.**

- b. "Let your need be made unto God." It does not say in fear.
- c. Fear-faith approaches God out of fear and fearful that your need won't be met.
- d. So you run all over to:
 - i. this pastor and this pastor
 - ii. to this counselor and this counselor
 - iii. or to this conference or to this healing conference
 - iv. or to many conferences for a "man of God" or a "woman of God" who will heal you.
- e. Not would you confess but what you hold in your heart.
 - i. "Well I think I'm..."
- f. What does Gods' word say?
 - i. "Out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks"
 - 1. **[Matthew 12:34b (KJV) ...for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh.]**
 - ii. "According to your faith so be it unto you."
 - 1. **[Matthew 9:29b (KJV) ...According to your faith be it unto you.]**
- g. Not his faith not her faith but your faith.

26. To come out of fear we must be willing to throw ourselves on the absolute care of God.



- a. Whether you win or lose. Whether you live whether you die. We must be able to trust God.
- b. Now we know all of us that God may not immediately answer all of our prayers right when we want Him to. But he will set things in motion to lead you out of that captivity and into your answer.
- c. But we can hold right here by saying one thing: “if I pray and then two weeks, six months or a year [latter] you don't see the answer to that prayer;
 - i. the enemy is going to come at you in a minute: “See God doesn't love you. You can't trust Him. You can't trust His word. He...”
 - 1. He's going to try and pull you back to all the people that you were not able to trust - that spoke words of promises to you and then broke those promises.
 - 2. Know that that is a device and a scheme of the enemy that he uses on everyone.
 - ii. That's when you have to rise up and say: “I don't trust you. I don't believe what these people did.”
 - iii. Because: every man is a liar, every man fall short of righteousness and fall short of the glory of God.
 - 1. **[Romans 3:4a (KJV)** God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar...]
 - 2. **[Romans 3:23 (KJV)** For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;]
 - iv. But I trust my God.
 - v. Though I lose, though I don't get this answer, I leave it with Him, He knows best.
- d. In God's word, it says: [Romans 12:18 paraphrased] “If at all possible... live peaceably one with another.”
 - i. [Slide: **Romans 12:18 (KJV)** If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.]
- e. [1 Timothy 6:5-8 paraphrased] “Those who equate gain with godliness,” it says: get away from them, “those who say gain is godliness from such turn away but I say that godliness with contentment is great gain.”
 - i. [Slide: **1 Timothy 6:5-8 (KJV)** ⁵ Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself. ⁶ But godliness with contentment is great gain. ⁷ For we brought nothing into *this* world, and

it is certain we can carry nothing out. ⁸ And having food and raiment let us be therewith content.]

- f. God's word is true.
 - i. So we Christians should be the most content people on the face of the Earth.
 - 1. Not in what we own. Not in what we possess. Not in a degree. Not because our son goes to this college or this university. Or my daughter is this professor or is this doctor or has this credential.
- g. Those who chase gain and wealth are tormented. Truly. You see someone with a lot of great wealth; if you are able to get to know them very very well: you would find that their some of the most miserable people on the face of this earth.
- h. That is why it says: It's so hard for a rich man to get into heaven.
 - i. [Slide: **Matthew 19:24 (KJV)** And again I say unto you, It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God.]
- i. Put aside:
 - i. the rudiments of your family tree
 - ii. the programming to please mom or dad
 - iii. the means and the patterns that you don't measure up
 - iv. that you have to do this.
 - v. Or, "oh... They're going to talk about me – I just can't take it anymore."
- j. Then stay away from them and build the boundaries around you very – very - very strong to keep out the stuff that is not godly.
 - i. Until you get yourself strong. Until your foundation is very secure and well rooted and grounded in the rock of God's truth, in the rock of God's word and in the rock of God's love for you that you can trust Him.

27. Fear will try to create your future for you.

- a. Because it represents the future because of some past event.
- b. Remember when I said faith and fear are equal? What are you meditating on each day?
 - i. Do you think about the things that you can't do?
 - ii. Are you thinking about all the things that are going to go wrong today?
- c. Or are you meditating on what you can do through Christ who strengthens you?
 - i. [**Philippians 4:13 (KJV)** I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.]
 - ii. What things you say I am going to complete this task today.

28. I didn't say this in the Unloving spirit video:

- a. But procrastination comes out of an unloving spirit.
- b. You procrastinate and put off because you don't trust yourself to be able to perform it and to get it done.
- c. It's difficult, so the difficult things that we have in our tasks to do today - you'll just kind of put them to the side because we just don't want to deal with it.

29. Isn't it so much interrelated with fear?

- a. "Well I don't know how to do it." "Maybe if I think about it longer." "Well I'll call so-and-so" and you call them and their busy.
- b. You can do it.
 - i. Speak to your spirit man to rise up strong. Pray for wisdom. Pray for revelation. Pray for understanding from God Almighty.

- ii. Be honest with Him and say: “Lord I don't know how to do it would you show me by your Spirit teach me these things.”
- iii. Rest and believe and be thankful that He’s going to do it.

30. Every man has been given the measure of faith.

- a. **[Romans 12:3c (KJV) ... according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.]**
- b. When you were a child or when I was:
 - i. We are writing a bicycle.
 - 1. When we fell off the bike – did we get back on? I did and I'm sure you did if you know how to ride bike.
 - 2. But if you had fallen down, even if you had gotten hurt and you said: “I’m never getting back on that bike again it hurts me.”
 - 3. Then you’re stuck and today you can't ride a bike.
 - ii. Let’s say you went to the swimming pond or the pool or the Lake:
 - 1. Someone played rough with you and held you under the water longer and you got fearful or traumatized.
 - 2. It's almost like you were going to know you were going to drown.
 - 3. You came up gasping for air and you went to the shore and you said: “I am never going to swim again.”
 - iii. That is Satan stealing your joy and your peace.
 - iv. What he did is to use that fowl person, it could have been a brother, could have been a friend, could have been a cousin or could have been your best friend at the time.
 - v. The demons could have used their actions to hold you down so your life could be wrapped in a spirit of fear from that point forward telling you: “ You can't trust anybody.”
 - vi. To get you to say: “I can't trust you God.”
 - vii. See how he works?

31. Uncover the lies of your past.

- a. Get on in your peace and the joy and the things that God wants you to do – enjoy.
- b. So you haven't swim for 35 years of your life and everyone else is swimming and having a great time, laughing and joking and having a good time. And you're on the shoreline sitting in your chair or sitting in the sand filling miserable. Like there's something wrong with you. Getting beat up in your feelings and emotions. By whom? By God? No! By the enemy that we let in or that we allowed in unknowingly because of a circumstance or situation in the past.
- c. I encourage you to stand strong and say: “My faith and my expectancy and what God wants to do for me is stronger than my fears.”

Faith always defeats fear.

32.

- a. You may say: “Well I've been believing for a long time and it has not happened yet.”

**Because you're going from fear to faith
there's work to do.**

- b.
 - i. We must address the issues creating the fear causing you to say such a thing as to say: “Well, I prayed.”

- c. Why do you give more power to fear?
 - i. Fearing that you're not going to get an answer.
 - ii. Fearing that this person isn't going to come to the Lord.
 - iii. Fearing that: "Oh, someone is going to think I'm a terrible person if they come over to my house and the house isn't clean." "Oh, what are they going to say about me?" Who cares what they say about you?
 - d. [Matthew 6:34 paraphrased] "Take no thought for tomorrow for the evil of today is sufficient."
 - i. [Matthew 6:34 (KJV) Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day *is* the evil thereof.]
 - ii. Keep your mind focused on today on what God wants to do for you today.
33. Fear is a ruling power in the world.
- a. Especially since 9/11.
 - b. We all have this issue to deal with:

Are we going to be in fear or are we going to stand in faith?

c.

It does not have to control you it does not have to rule your life. You can choose to be free.

d.

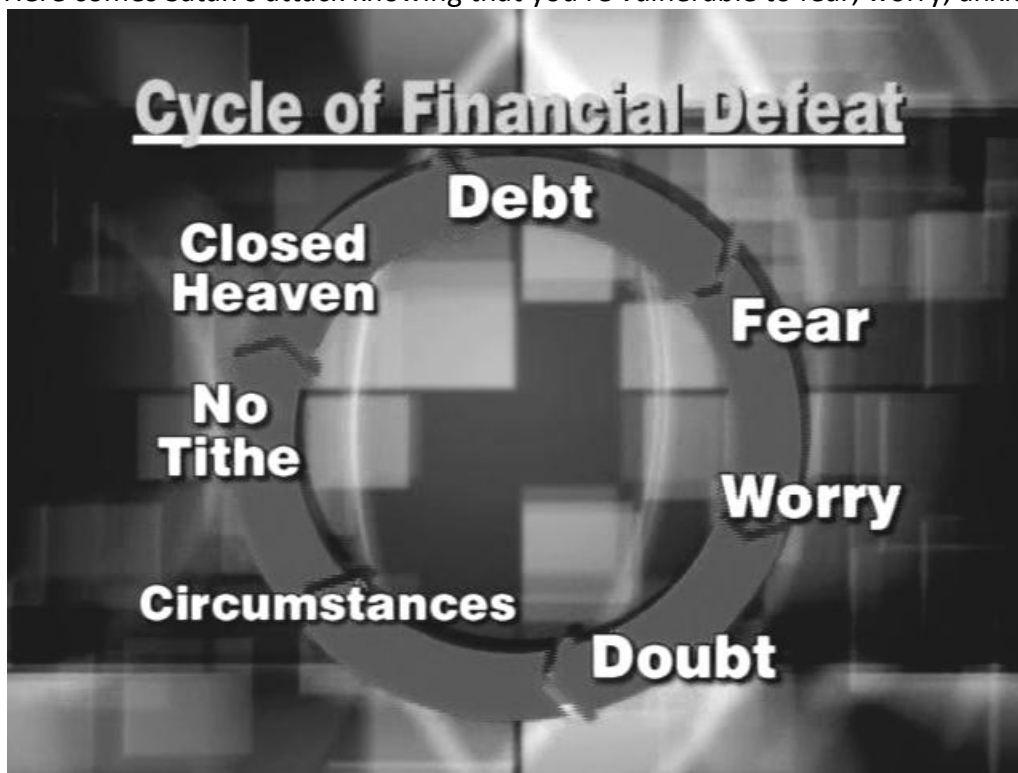
- e. In Luke 12:22 [-24 paraphrased] "And He said unto his disciples: therefore I say unto you 'take no thought': care, worry, concern, 'for your life, what you shall eat; neither for the body; what you shall put on. The life is more than meat, and the body is more than raiment. Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap...' Are we to sow and reap for our harvest so that we can reap our plenty? 'Which neither have storehouse nor barn and God feeds them: how much more are you better than the fowls?'"
 - i. [Slide: **Luke 12:22-24 (KJV)** ²² And he said unto his disciples, Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat; neither for the body, what ye shall put on. ²³ The life is more than meat, and the body *is more* than raiment. ²⁴ Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap; which neither have storehouse nor barn; and God feedeth them: how much more are ye better than the fowls?]
- f. He goes on from there and He talks about: [Luke 12:27-34 paraphrased] "... 'Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not; and yet I say unto you that Solomon in all his glory' money, raiment, wisdom, 'was not arrayed like one of these. If then God so clothe the grass, which is today in the field and tomorrow is cast into the oven; how much more will he clothe you, O ye of little faith. And seek not what you shall eat, or what you shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful of mind.' Don't be into doubt. Don't be into unbelief. 'For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knows that you have need of these things. But rather' seek you 'seek ye the kingdom of God and all these things shall be added unto you. Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom...' Verse 34 'For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.'"

- i. [Slides: **Luke 12:27-34 (KJV)** ²⁷ Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not; and yet I say unto you, that Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these. ²⁸ If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more *will he clothe* you, O ye of little faith? ²⁹ And seek not ye what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink, neither be ye of doubtful mind. ³⁰ For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knoweth that ye have need of these things. ³¹ But rather seek ye the kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. ³² Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good pleasure to give you the kingdom. ³³ Sell that ye have, and give alms; provide yourselves bags which wax not old, a treasure in the heavens that faileth not, where no thief approacheth, neither moth corrupteth. ³⁴ For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.]

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34. [An Example:]

- a. I'm going to paint a little picture about this cycle of financial defeat.
- b. Here comes Satan's attack knowing that you're vulnerable to fear, worry, anxiety and stress.



- i. He brings in this debt at 12 o'clock.
 - ii. He wants to lead us into fear about two - three o'clock.
 - iii. Four – five, he wants to lead us into worry which will lead us into doubt.
 - iv. We're going to get around six-seven o'clock. The eyes upon our particular circumstances.
 - v. Which now the circumstances become so huge we're going to:
 1. stop giving to God paying our tithes
 2. giving to the church
 3. giving to the work of the kingdom.
 - vi. God closes the heavens over our prayer life and were bound.
- c. In Matthew 6:25 [paraphrased] "...take no thought' do not worry, do not fret, do not be overanxious, 'for your life'"

- i. [Slide: **Matthew 6:25 (KJV)** Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what ye shall eat, or what ye shall drink; nor yet for your body, what ye shall put on. Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?]
- ii. Just what I read in Luke 12.
- d. So if it's in Matthew and it's in Luke, 1 Peter 5:7] also refers to it.
 - i. [**1 Peter 5:7 (KJV)** Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.]
- e. Don't be of little faith. Let's don't take thought or worry.

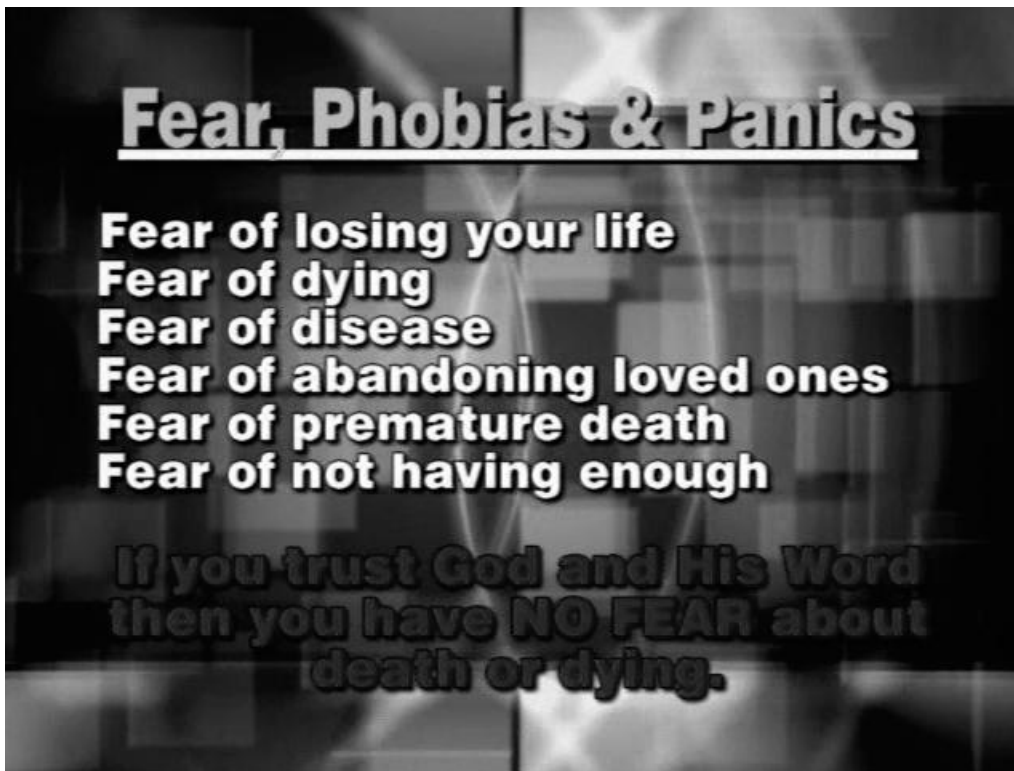
35. [Seek the Kingdom First:]

- a. Remember what it says in God's word: [Matthew 6:33] "Seek ye first the kingdom of God and his righteousness."
 - i. [**Matthew 6:33 (KJV)** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.]
- b. What is the kingdom of God? The kingdom of God is peace. [Romans 14:17]
 - i. [**Romans 14:17 (KJV)** For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.]
- c. Peace at all costs. When you have Shalom (peace) you have everything and you need nothing more.
- d. Look up the definition in the Hebrew of Shalom: It's all that you need. God wants to give to you: in peace, righteousness, (righteousness - right standing) who you are in Christ Jesus,
 - i. an offspring an heir to the King.
 - ii. To the King with the cattle on a thousand hills.
 - iii. To the King of the universe that owns everything.
 - iv. Not just the King of a kingdom. Not like Scheck in Iran, or Iraq or Saudi Arabia that has a hundred million dollars and you're an heir.
 - v. You're and heir to the one who owns all the Scheck's and all of the things that each of the kingdoms on the earth - on the planet owns.
 - vi. You're an heir to those things.
- e. And "joy in the Holy Ghost."

36. The joy of the Lord is your strength.

- a. [**Nehemiah 8:10c (KJV)** ...for the joy of the LORD is your strength.]
- b. Why are you downcast oh my soul?
 - i. [**Psalms 42:5 (KJV)** Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and *why* art thou disquieted in me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him *for* the help of his countenance.]
- c. Why are you depressed, anxious or heavy.
- d. When you have the spirit of heaviness upon you it says in God's word [Isaiah 61:3 paraphrased]: to put on the garment of praise and thanksgiving to the Lord God Almighty.
 - i. [**Isaiah 61:3 (KJV)** To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.]
- e. When we go into fears, phobias or panics it's nothing more than the mind-body connection of what were listening to - what we've listen to for years.

37. [Fear, Phobias & Panics:]



- a. [Fears]
 - i. Fear of losing your life.
 - ii. Fear of dying.
 - iii. Fear of disease.
 - iv. Fear of abandoning your loved ones.
 - v. Fear of premature death.
 - vi. Fear of not having enough.
- b. If you're right with God than you have no fear about your life, death and dying or the process.
 - i. We get into fear over dying because we don't know where we're going to go.
 - ii. Do you understand that?

38. Another aspect [of fear:]

- a. – we will switch.
- b. Another aspect of fear for you to consider whether there's a stronghold of Fear in your life - influencing you.

All contingency plans are usually made out of fear.

- c.
- d. Because you don't trust the one plan vision that God's given you.
 - i. "We'll let's make plans to go to... When we go on our trip we will here and we will stop there. But if, you know, the car breaks down or we don't have enough money or if we don't have enough gas. Then instead of going here then will just make the short trip over here.
 - ii. Did you hear? "Well if we don't have enough money. If we don't have enough gas."

Fear will take you into pursuing the permissive will of God and not the perfect will of God for your life.

e.

God's perfect will is His best but fear will always settle for second best.

f.

g.

h.

i.

**Fear reminds you who you are not.
Fear reminds you what you don't have.**

Fear reminds you of all the things in your life that went wrong and projects those wrong things into your future.

- j. Do we settle with staying in the outer court of God's presence or do we yearn and desire, even if our feelings are scrambled;
- k. Do we say: "No Lord I want to press into you. I want to hear your voice. I want to experience your presence. I want your loving arms to be wrapped round about me. I want to have visions. I want to have dreams."
- l. "Lord says in the Bible [1 Cor. 14:39 paraphrased] "that we all should desire to prophesy."
 - i. [1 Corinthians 14:39 (KJV) Wherefore, brethren, covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues.]
- m. "Lord I have a desire to prophesy. I want to be an oracle of God. I want to hear from you and speak to the church. To speak to my family. To speak to my friends. What is your desire for our life. "
 - i. (Not out of some psychic line experience or occultic thing.)
- n. Because then people are going to like me, they're going to accept me and I'm not going to do it out of my need for attention-getting.

- o. He knows your heart. Press into Him. Don't stay back.
- p. Say: "I choose to trust God and His word whether I live or I die I am at peace. I am not concerned about tomorrow. "

39. [Defeating Fear:]

- a. So you have to understand:

We're not able to defeat fear until we get rid of the Unloving spirit.

- i.
- b. That's why we have the video series [this teaching series] where we encourage you to do the Unloving spirit first and then address the spirit of Fear.

- c. Because:

If we cannot receive God's perfect love and to begin to love ourselves as God loves us then we will never defeat a spirit of Fear.

- i.
- d. For God's word is true.
- e. [I John 4:18] "Perfect love casts out fear."
 - i. **[1 John 4:18 (KJV)]** There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.]
 - ii. Also in [this] scripture it says: "fear has torment."
 - iii. How many of us have been tormented?

- f. We must resolve this:

A self-esteem issue is a love issue.

- i.
- g. God's word says [James 4:10 paraphrased] "If we will humble ourselves before the hand of God, the arms of God, His loving embrace, in due season He will raise us up."
 - i. **[James 4:10 (KJV)]** Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.]
- h. Let's be mature in our season. Where we are in this life today. Where we are.
 - i. Don't let fear stifle your growth another day.
 - j. Trust God and build in the season of time for your healing your restoration your freedom.
 - k. Now, you're going to hear, (even after this teaching is done.):
 - i. "Yeah, but he doesn't know about your symptom. Well what about these feelings that you have now?"
 - l. Fear drives you - Faith will lead you. Fear will hold you in condemnation - Faith and God will only lead you to conviction.



- m. "Are there some things that I need to change in my life?" versus "You've done this and you've done that. Oh, you're never going to make it now."
- n. Grab that thought by its scrawny neck and kick it out and say "Lord you've convicted me - gently leading me to take this step in your direction."

40. [More on Fear:]

- a. Fear wants to take away that season of time when God perfect you in your life.
- b. Fear will take away that season and he will demand action right now and he'll say: "God's a liar. You can't trust Him. Look what they've done to you."
- c. Rejection, fear of failure, unloving and thinking that you're not good enough - those are all lies. Those are all lies that you have to recognize. Those are all lies that you have to recognize.
- d. Promise without discernment is still bondage.



- e. If we stand on: “Well that's a promise of God but I can't trust God and look what happened to me.”
- f. Without discerning the truth of what you're saying and what you are speaking – you're still going to be in bondage.
- g. Let's go from the cursing's to the blessings.
- h. Remember and in Deuteronomy 28 [2, 30:19] it says:
 - i. “Choose you this day blessings or curses.”
 - ii. The first 16 verses, of the chapter of 28 talks about the blessings. There's no diseases. There's no curses in those verses if you're obedient, if you trust God, if you follow his word and do all that his word says - you'll have blessings and you'll have life.
 - iii. But the next 20 some verses [Deut 28:16-58] thereafter outline all the diseases and curses that are going to come into your life if you don't follow God's word and trust Him.
- i. God's love for us is incredible.
- j. Fear is a lie. Don't listen to lies.
- k. I encourage you don't be a partaker of all of the evil in the world that the world dangles out in front of us and tries to attract to us:
 - i. Fear of food.
 - ii. Fear of drink.
 - iii. You know the allergies because I can't eat this it's going to compromise my immune system.

41. [Allergies relationship to Fear]

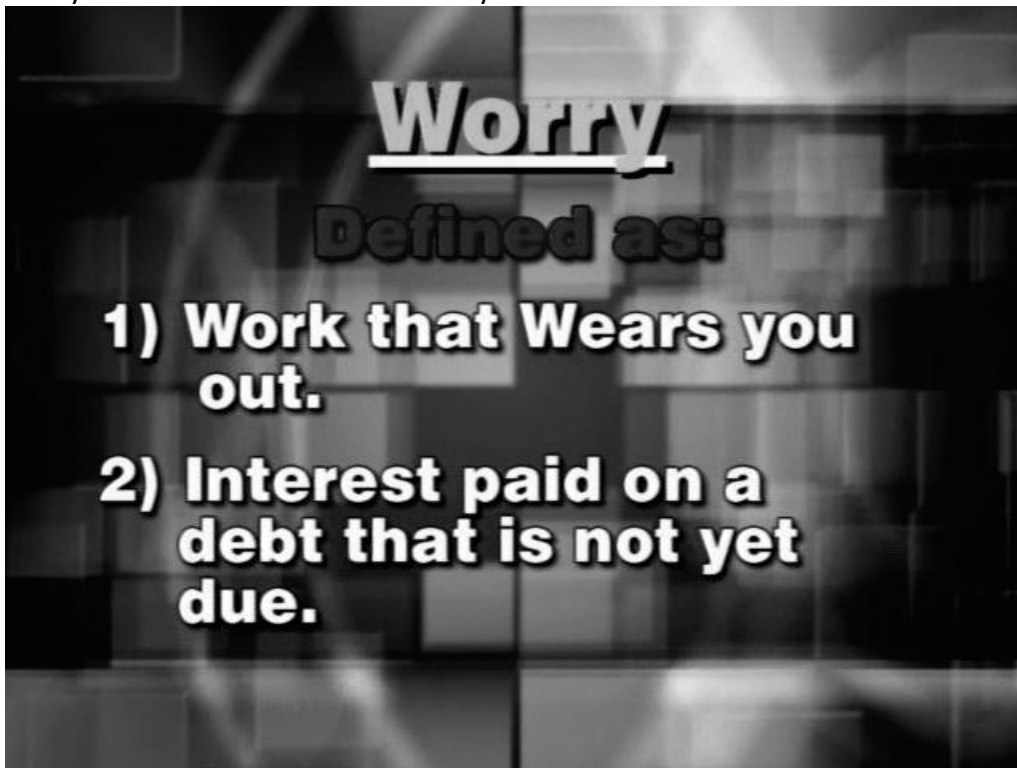
- a. When we have a strong immune system there are no allergies.
- b. The allergist will say well avoid this and avoid that avoid is the term building on fear.
- c. All allergies come from fear.
- d. In the fear stress physiology teaching we're going to show you the medical insight from the medical community which is going to outline, where fear, where it comes into our thinking and how it disrupts destroys our body.

42. [Compulsive Behavior link to Fear:]

- a. If we have a fear of not having enough a fear of lack it's connected with an Unloving spirit.
- b. Out of it comes: compulsive spending, theft, kleptomania and shoplifting. It's all rooted: in an Unloving spirit, in fear of poverty, fear of lack.
- c. What happens is a dopamine rush.
 - i. We go into a store and we take something.
 - ii. Our hearts are racing.
 - iii. We are all pumped up.
 - iv. We get out of the store [and with the] dopamine rush we going to sleep for 3 or 4 hours.
- d. Ask any serious shoplifter the cycle that they go through.
- e. It's no different than someone else that has an addiction. It's a cycle.

43. [Fear is not Trusting God:]

- a. We [should] have no fear of failing - we're a child of Christ.
- b. Fear of man, fear failure and all of that comes of: "not trusting God."
- c. Hebrews 5:14 "discerning both good and evil"
 - i. **[Hebrews 5:14 (KJV)]** But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, *even* those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.]
- d. Pray for the gift of discerning of spirits – pray.
- e. Worry is defined as work that wears you out.



- f. Worry is work that wears you out.
- g. The devil is like a roaring lion,[1 Peter 5:8] a bully, a lot of hot air, full of fear of man full of fear of not being good enough Satan is full of fear of judgment.
 - i. **[1 Peter 5:8 (KJV)]** Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:]
 - ii. "Have you come to torment us" these spirits said through the madman of Gardena.
 1. **[Matthew 8:29 (KJV)]** And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God? art thou come hither to torment us before the time?]

- h. He knows his time is short.
- i. Out of a fear of Rejection comes a fear of judgment. Fearful.
- j. 1 John 4:18 “fear has torment”
 - i. [1 John 4:18 (KJV) There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.]
 - ii. We don’t want to be in torment, we want our peace.
- k. I encourage you: You want your peace or you wouldn't be watching this video.
- l. Recognize the fears which have been a part of your battle in the generations. Those that you have to deal with.
- m. I encourage you: If you have a fear of heights go grab somebody that doesn't have of fear heights and go walk-up that Ranger tower. Go walk up those heights that you’ve never been able to do.

The key thing to each of us being free is to recognize the parts of our existence that are not truly us.

- n.
- o. We don’t want to bow our knee to become one with Satan, Fear and his kingdom. One with his nature.

The beginning of all freedom is when you come out of agreement with all the junk and become one with the nature of God our Father who is love.

- q. Have you washed your car when it became dirty? No - leave it dirty. You wash it. It’s time to begin the washing:
 - i. of our minds
 - ii. of the patterns and habits in our life.
- r. When I said if you have a fear of heights, if you have a fear of being in crowds, grab someone that isn't and walk around in those crowds.
- s. If you have a fear of claustrophobia go do something in a tight place professing Jesus and speaking to it.
- t. I gave an example of:
 - i. I was working construction and I had to go...
 - ii. We built this frames a mud-room. Just a space about this far [he placed his hands about 1.5 feet apart] and over at the far end and we forgot to hook up the ductwork.
 - iii. And so, Jim, who I worked with, said: “Bill go on down in there and go on the bottom.”
 - iv. Well I got in that hole and started moving... I mean, I like froze. I panicked and I came up out of that hole and said: “Well Jim you know I can’t fit very good”, and he's bigger then I am, so Jim went down to do it.
 - v. Soon as I came up and I said that, I thought: “It's that fowl spirit of fear and claustrophobia.” I repented right then and I said: “Lord give me another opportunity. “

- vi. It was no more than a month later my uncle came and said that there was a wire in the front of his trailer that he needed to bring to the back of his trailer for a new switch. He's in his 70s.
- vii. He said: "Bill could you help me with it?" [Bill responded] "Well sure."
- viii. Well when he pulled back the insulation from underneath his trailer, I mean it is dark there is no more than this much room [again holding his hands about 1 -1.5 feet apart]. In the dirt and totally dark.
- ix. Well I said: "Lord thank you for the test I'm going to break this spirit of fear and claustrophobia that has been over my dad and over me in the past. In your strength and help I'm going to get through this."
- x. I crawled down there, my heart is racing, you know -clammy hands.
- xi. I'm just saying: "Jesus" the whole time.
- xii. Get to the end and find the wire and bring it back.
- xiii. When I finally got to the end where the wire was, I was fine.
- u. I know my wife has a testimony about she had a fear of snakes:
 - i. The kids went to the zoo and the instructor had this huge 5 foot rat snake that they were showing the kids.
 - ii. Breanna and William were six and eight years old and they touched it.
 - iii. And said: "Oh mom, touch it."
 - iv. She was backing away kind of at a distance and the teacher said well you know to break your fear you should hold the snake.
 - v. There was no way Diane was going to do it.
 - vi. But because her children said: "Oh mama come on - let's do this"
 - vii. She took a breath and said: "Well okay."
 - viii. She said: "I had this flush heat go down my face. My heart was racing. I got dizzy in my mind and in my brain. My hands were all clammy. I thought I was going to faint."
 - ix. "Then it went down, as I held onto this thing, down through my feet and I was at peace."
 - x. "I was holding the snake and actually it didn't feel cold and slimy it was fine. I petted it and I was at peace."
- v. I wouldn't ask you to do something that we haven't done to defeat the fowl spirit of Fear.
- w. You can do this.
- x. It's your choice: You will either be bound by Fear in your life and in your body. Or you will choose, with help, to get free.
